

ARP Grant Info

Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) authorized by the American Rescue Plan (ARP).

1. PC AGE Career Institute (PC AGE) acknowledges that on June 28, 2021, the institution has received funding under the ARP (a)(4) ALN 84.425Q supplemental grant award to be distributed to students in accordance with the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (P.L. 117-2).
2. PC AGE has received \$182,673.00 in total for ARP funds for student Aid from the Department of Education pursuant to the Certification and Agreement (for) Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
3. PC AGE has distributed \$60,946 under American Rescue Plan (ARP) as of March 31, 2022.
4. There are **31** estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grant under the American Rescue Plan (ARP).
5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the ARP program were **31** students.
6. PC AGE has decided to apply the same guidelines and distribution plan set up under the CRRSAA (a)4) program which are the following:
 - All students who or could be eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended (HEA), may receive financial aid grants.
 - All students who are eligible for Pell grants, federal or state need-based aid, are enrolled in distance education, and who needs assistance to pay for their tuition fees due to the COVID-19 pandemic will receive an equal amount of \$2,000 each.
7. PC AGE's Admission Officers provide instructions, directions, or guidance to students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants.
